Kendwa Rocks is an one-hour drive from Zanzibar Town towards the northern tip of the island. The road descends to one of the most fantastic beaches in East Africa. From the beach you see the lighthouse of the nearby Tumbatu Island. Beautiful sunsets are an everyday thrill and moonlighted nights on the white coral and seashell beach make an unforgettable experience. The choice of accommodation is ample: choose a spacious suite or family room, coral stone or palmwood bungalow or just a simple palmwood banda! The rooms are surrounded by coconut trees and lush tropical gardens.

#### **CITY TOUR**

Zanzibar City Tours - It may not have a particularly romantic name, but Stone Town is the oldest city and cultural heart of Zanzibar, little changed in the last 200 years. It is a place of winding alleys, bustling bazaars, mosques and grand Arab houses whose original owners vied with each other over the extravagance of their dwellings. This one-upmanship is particularly reflected in the brass-studded, carved, <u>wooden doors</u> – there are more than 500 different examples of this handiwork. You can spend many idle hours and days just wandering through the fascinating labyrinth of narrow streets and alleyways.

This is a walking tour that takes you through fabled Stone Town, where history appears to stand still. With visits to the House of Wonders, the former slave market for East African Slave trade, and the Arab Fort amongst others, it is a fascinating look at the essence of Zanzibar. The architectural style of Stone Town buildings is a unique mixture of various influences and culture.

You will see Zanzibar's bustling market, winding alleyways, ornately carved and studded doors, two cathedrals and countless mosques.

Stone Town has some excellent gifts shops with plenty of souvenirs and handicrafts to choose from.

We will take a guided walk through this colorful and alternating city with knowledgeable tour guides, who know not only the funny stories, but also the cruel stories about life in the history of Stone town.

The Stone Town tour is a walking tour and takes almost 3 hrs in the narrow streets. The half day trip includes the guide and all entrance fees of scheduled stops.

#### PRISON ISLAND TOUR

Prison Island. This was built in 1893 and was originally intended to house violent prisoners from the mainland and sick people.

You will get the opportunity to visit the tortoise sanctuary, which contains a large colony of giant tortoise imported from the Seychelles in the late 19th century. The average weight of these creatures is 200 kg, and many of them are said to be over 150 years old. There will be a chance to touch the tortoise and take photos. The island is also a home to a colony of beautiful peacocks.

For the rest of the trip you can either enjoy the marine life or just relax under the warm glow of the sun, until we head back to Stone Town.
