Santiago

Arrival day, **Wed, Feb 16**- Land in the capital of Praia at 12:30pm where you will be greeted by an English speaking host. Check into your hotel, then head next door to have lunch at Campanhas Restaurant. While waiting on your food, our trusted exchanger Edu will come meet with you to exchange your money. Afterward, visit the first port of the trans Atlantic slave trade, UNESCO World Heritage Site Cidade Velha. Stop at the Fort Real Sao Filipe constructed to protect the town from frequent pirate attacks, the oldest Portuguese organized street in the tropics, and the old pelourinho (slave post). Enjoy a live performance of the once forbidden Batuko. Relax a bit before your welcome dinner in an intimate courtyard complete with a serenade from a renown Coboverdean singer. (Dinner Included)

Thurs, Feb 17 – Experience the authentic culture and charm of Cape Verde when you wind through the mountainous countryside and stop for a hands on lesson on the history of women and ceramics in the tight-knit community of Fonte Lima. Have lunch "na linha" (cooked on firewood) at a local farm, then head to Tarrafal, the island most beautiful beach town. Spend the night overlooking the Atlantic ocean, allowing its waves to lull you to sleep. (Lunch & Dinner Included)









Fri, Feb 18- Relax on the gorgeous Tarrafal beach or in your hotel's natural infinity pool, followed by a delish lunch by a stellar **Swiss Chef** who puts a Cape Verde twist on his dishes. Drive back to Praia winding along the eastern coast, stopping to visit the Rabelados (Rebels) to see how they are preserving traditional culture. Rest up for a bit, before heading out for dinner and a taste of **Praia's night** life with a host and transport.(Lunch & Dinner Included)

Sat, Feb 19- Consider pampering yourself with a 1hr full body optional massage (scheduled throughout the day). In your leisure time consider strolling on your own throught the historic Plateau and stop to see the bustling and colorful Mercado Municipal where the 'Badias' (Santiago women) are hard at work. Or relax and people watch at Prainha or Kebra Kanela beach. Meet for lunch, then go on a street art/souvenir shopping tour mash up. That night attend a Dispidida then enjoy (Cape Verde going away celebration) dinner of home-cooked cachupa, the national dish, and drinks at the home of our local host; followed by a rooftop lesson on the traditional dances of Cape Verde and the sensual kizomba, and private dance party with a DJ and specially invited local guests. (Lunch and dinner with snacks and drinks included)

Sun, Feb 20 - HORA D'BAI One of our hosts will escort you to the Nelson Mandela National Airport for your departure.

ADDITIONAL INFO

NO VISA REQUIRED for US citizens staying for 30 days or less

Airport tax of approximately \$35 usd must be paid upon arrival in Cape Verde (can be paid in CV escudos, euros or Visa credit card)

Vaccinations for Americans are not required, but some visitors prefer to make sure they have had hepatitis A and typhoid vaccines

Travel insurance is mandatory

In Cape Verde many places accept only cash or the CV debit card. You can arrive with cash (dollars or euros) and then exchange them to CV escudos, or withdraw it from any of the many ATM machines

Covid PCR Tests will be arranged by our local vendor if still in effect.
