11 Days, 10 Nights Package

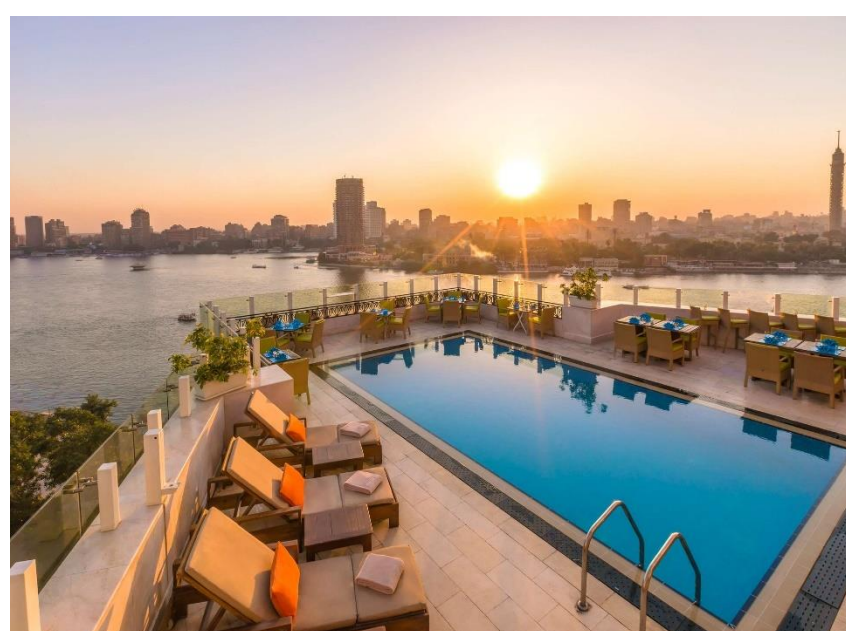
September 13th – 23rd, 2024

Day 1, Friday September 13th: Arrival Cairo -Welcome to land of the Pharaoh's.

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, you will be whisked off via air-conditioned deluxe vehicle to your hotel. At the hotel, the representative will assist you to check-in and review your tours to Egypt tours itinerary to confirm the pick-up times for each tour. You will visit the jewelry store and get the chance to buy the cartouches and the beautiful Egyptian jewelry. Then you will visit the famous Papyrus institute where you will learn about the history of papyrus paper and ancient artwork. There, you'll get the chance to see and buy the beautiful painting on the papyrus. Later on, you will be transferred back to your hotel where you will relax until your formal welcome dinner.

Day 2, Saturday September 14th: Giza Pyramids and Grand Egyptian Museum

After your breakfast at the hotel, you will move with your private tour guide to the famous Giza Plateau to start the Egypt travel by visiting the only remaining wonder from the original Seven Wonders of the Ancient World - the Great Pyramids of Khufu (called Cheops by the Ancient Greeks). On the plateau are the pyramids of Khafre (Chephren) and the smallest Pyramid Menkaure (Mykerinos). Then stop for lunch and after that continue to the Grand Egyptian Museum, where the boy king Tutankhamen's treasures await you. Later on, you will be transferred back to your hotel and overnight in Cairo. Dinner is at leisure tonight.

Day 3, Sunday, September 15th: Fly Cairo to Aswan –Tour to Kemet Egypt

After breakfast, you will checkout from the hotel in Cairo, and then you will be transferred to Cairo Airport Domestic Terminal for your flight to Aswan. On arrival in Aswan, you will be met by your Tour Guide and commence your day of Aswan tours. You'll cross by boat to Agilika Island to see the Temple of Isis at Philae, which is one of the Nubian Temples rescued before the High Dam was built. Enjoy Philae's long colonnades, towers, and reliefs, including the last surviving hieroglyphic and demotic inscriptions in Egypt. Visit the center of aromatherapy and essential oils as Aswan consider to be the capital of herbs and natural essential oils over Africa, and then transfer to your stay in Aswan. You will also visit the Egyptian cotton store and get the chance to buy the Egyptian galabyia for the galabyia party. After a full day of adventure, you will enjoy a special white party at the Nubian Village where you will listen to Nubian folklore and experience a Nubian dinner. **Accommodation:** Nubian House **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner



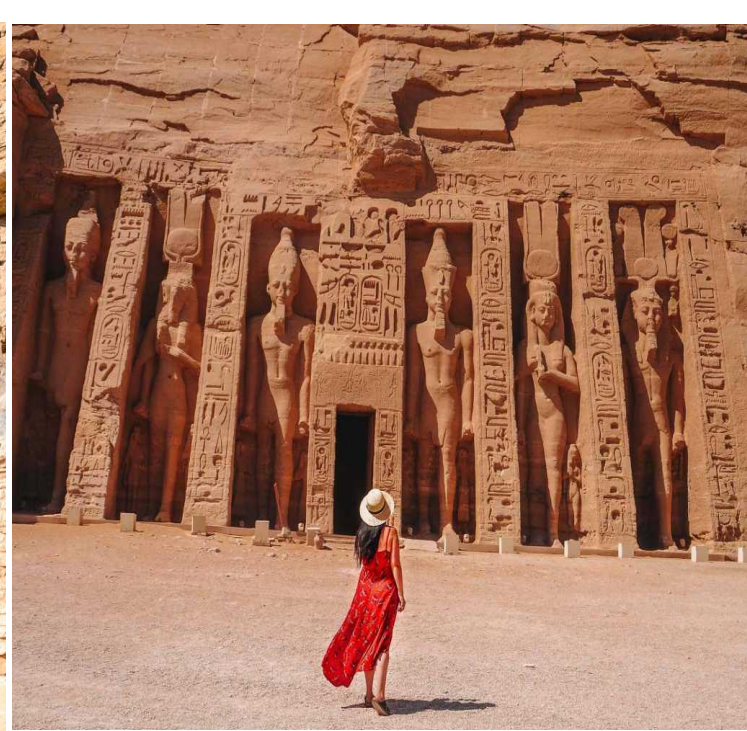
Day 4, Monday, September 16th : Private Tour to Philae Temple / Nile Cruise

After breakfast, you will be taken on a 3hr drive to Abu Simbel to tour The Two Temples of Abu Simbel. With their unique style, they are considered to be the masterpieces of ancient Egypt. They reflect the glory and grandeur of the new Kingdom. The Egyptian government and UNESCO decided to co-operate to save these temples from flooding. The Temple of Ramesses II was dedicated to the four universal gods Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and Ramesses II himself. The great Abu Simbel temple is also called The Sun Temple of Ramesses II. The Temple of Queen Nefertari is also Called Temple of Hathor, who was the wife of the Sun God so symbolically, the two Temples, that of Ramesses II and that of Nefertari, bring Ramesses II, Nefertari, Hathor, and the Sun God together as one. Later on, you will be escorted back from Abu Simbel to Aswan, where you'll embark on a Nile cruise. You'll spend the night onboard the cruise.

Day 5, Tuesday September 17th: Kom Ombo Temple and Edfu

By the morning, you will enjoy Sailing to Kom Ombo while getting breakfast on board. Arrive at Kom Ombo to visit the Temple shared by two gods Sobek and Haeroris in Kom Ombo. Back to your Nile cruise to sail to Edfu with lunch on board. On arrival at Edfu, our guide will accompany you to visit the Horus Temple at Edfu by a Kaless ride (horse and carriage). Explore the huge Ptolemaic Temple of Horus at Edfu, which is the most complete and best-preserved of the Egyptian Temples, consisting of many columns, halls, chambers, and chapels. Two statues of

Horus flank the twin-towered entrance gate. Enjoy an afternoon tea during the sailing to Esna. Later on, you will enjoy dinner on board and spend the night on your Nile Cruise Ship.

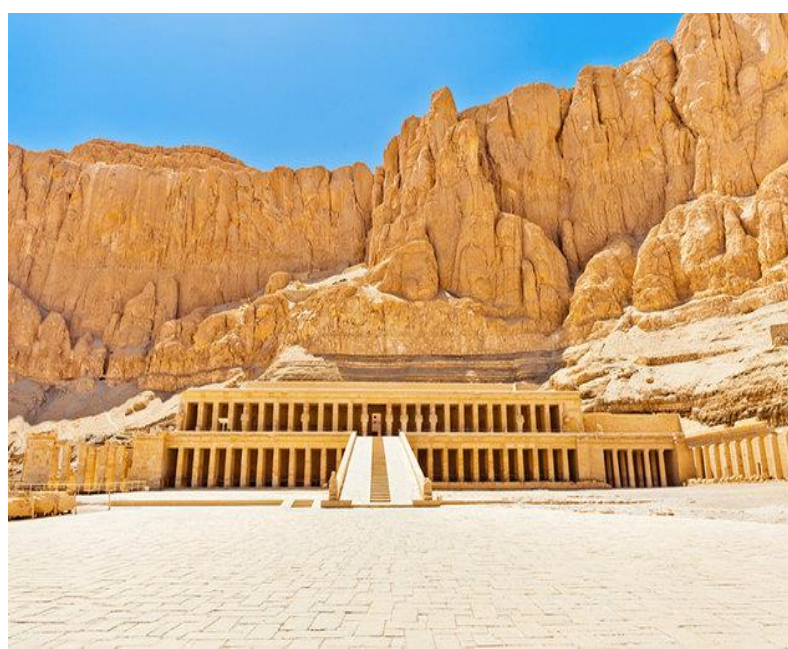


Day 6, Wednesday September 18th: Luxor Nile Cruise Tours

In the early morning, you will sail to Luxor while enjoying your breakfast on board, then set out from your cruise, where you will visit the West Bank of Luxor. Start your tour by visiting the royal cemetery for 64 Pharaohs in the Valley of the Kings. Then, you will move to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut (the only Female Pharaoh) at El Deir EL Bahari and the two towering statues of the Colossi of Memnon. You'll enjoy dinner on board and spend the night in Luxor.

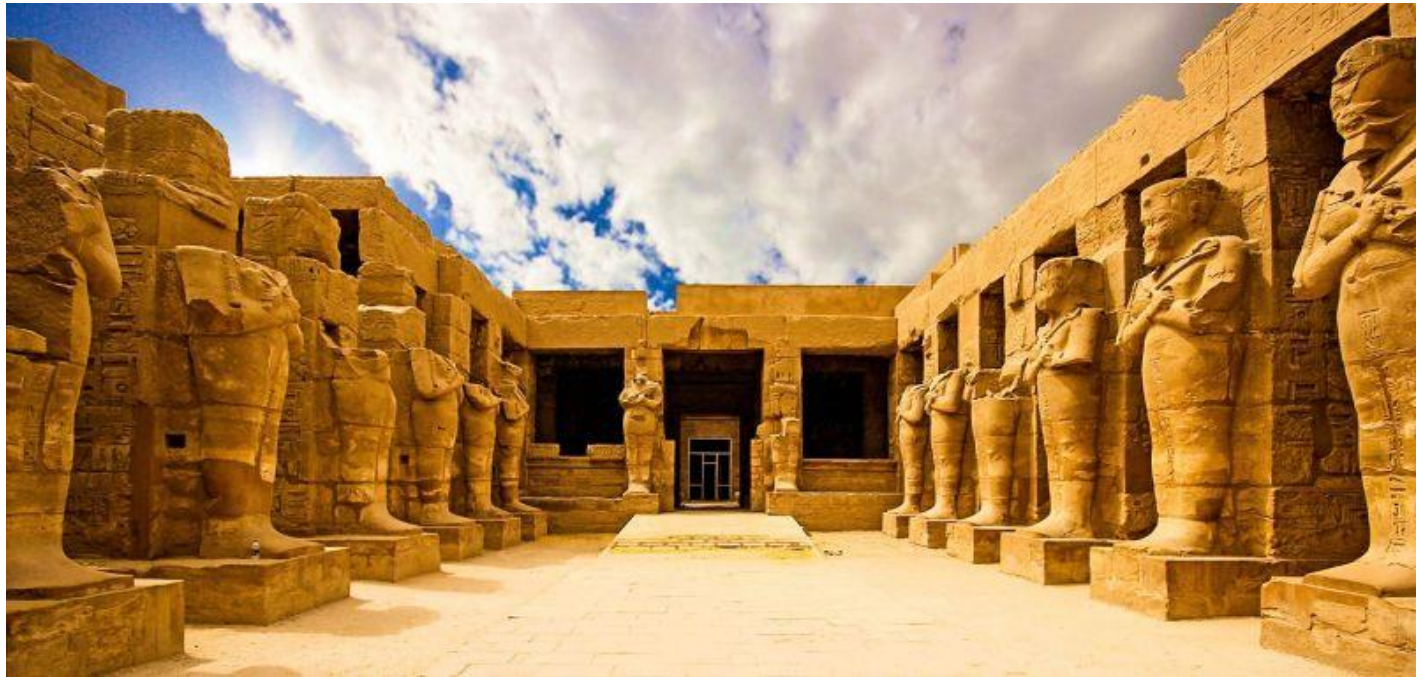


Day 7, Thursday September 19th: Karnak Temples- Transfer to Hurghada
