#### Day 3, Saturday March 30<sup>th</sup>: Welcome to Turmi – Mursi & Hamer People

After breakfast you will be driven to Mago national park to visit the **Mursi ethnic group**, who are known for their lower lip and earlobe plates. Afterwards, you will continue driving to **Turmi**, home of the **Hamer people**. On the way, stop in **Dimeka for the local market**, which is on Tuesdays and Saturday. This is one of the most colorful markets in the South Omo and is visited by neighborhood Hamer, Benna, Karo, Tsemai and Ari tribes. At night, enjoy the **traditional night dancing of the Hamer people, known as <b>Evangadi**. After a full day of adventure, retire to the comfortable and welcoming Turmi Buska Lodge for a relaxing overnight stay.

#### Day 4, Sunday March 31st: Day Trip to Omorate – Dassenech & Karo People

After breakfast you will embark on a day trip to Omorate to visit the Dassenech or Karo people. Here you will Cross the Omo River by local boat and enter a Dassenech village or Karo tribe. The Karo people are the smallest in number of all the tribes of the Omo Valley, and they are known for their elaborate decorations particularly during local ceremonies. Later on, you'll enjoy an overnight stay at Turmi Buska Lodge.






#### Day 5, Monday April 1st: Return to Addis Ababa

After breakfast you will be driven from Turmi to Jinka Airport. You will enjoy a local lunch or picnic in Jinka before flying back to Addis Ababa. Upon arrival you will check back into Getfam Hotel. Later, you will convene with the group for a traditional evening of live music and local cuisine at the famous Yod Abyssinian Cultural House.

Set within Haile Selassie's former palace, Addis Ababa University's main campus is the Enthralling Ethnological Museum. Before lunch, you will be driven to Holy Trinity Cathedral Church which has a unique architectural style. Upon completion of lunch, you will visit Entoto Mountains, the best location to observe the panoramic view of the capital. It is also a historical place where Menelik II resided and built his palace. After a full day of exploring, retreat to the luxurious Getfam Hotel in Addis Ababa for a comfortable overnight stay.




#### Day 7, Wednesday April 3<sup>rd</sup>: Addis Ababa – Lalibela – UNESCO World Heritage

You will start visit the World wonders of Lalibela rock hewn churches. You will learn of the fascinating history and the 3 different classifications. Today you will focus on the 1<sup>st</sup> group. Upon completion you will return to your accommodation to relax and enjoy the amenities.


# Day 8, Thursday April 4<sup>th</sup>: Lalibela Rock Churches – Ethiopian Coffee Ceremony







# Day 9, Friday April 5<sup>th</sup>: Welcome to Gondar
