DAY 2: SATURDAY 5th JULY 2025

<u>Kigali City Tour – Sights, Sounds, Cuisine, Locals & History</u>

After breakfast you will embark on a Kigali Walking City Tour. You will explore the green capital full of palm trees and magnificent landmarks. The first part of the walking tour will conclude with an hour hike to mount Kigali, where you will have a spectacular view of Kigali city. You will later descend and drive to explore Nyamirambo which is known as old Kigali. There you will engage and learn about the incredible Nyamirambo Women Group as you trek with them through the city to discover more hidden treasures and learn about the vibrant culture and their vast contributions. In the process you will learn some Kinyarwanda words and meet the local venders selling organic produce and the like. Upon completion you will enjoy some local Kinyarwanda cuisine for lunch. You will later proceed to Kigali genocide memorial ground where over 250,000 victims of genocide incidence of 1994 were laid to rest. You will be given an in-depth tour and history on this tragic past in Rwanda's history. Upon leaving the memorial grounds you will drive to Kimironko local market where you can support local artists and vendors. Your tour ends at about 4.00pm with a drop off at the designated hotel. The rest of the evening is yours to spend at leisure until our welcome group dinner. 




DAY 3: SUNDAY 6th JULY 2025

Genocide: Nynamata & Ntarama Memorial & Mbyo Reconciliation Village - Hutu & Tutsi

Today's focus will be to learn, engage and walk away with a deeper understanding of the Rwandan Genocide of 1994. After breakfast you will drive south of Kigali heading to **Ntarama and Nyamata genocide memorial sites** which is roughly a 45 minutes' drive. These two sites will give you tremendous insight into the entire genocide. You will be able to get a wealth of information about how the entire genocide began. Ntarama's former Catholic Church is now a memorial site where 5,000 people were massacred there on the 15 August 1994. This memorial center is one of **six major centers'** in Rwanda that commemorates the Rwandan Genocide. You will later head to visit **Nyamata** believe to be the starting point of the genocide, and its surrounding region which suffered some of the most devastation, and horrifying violence that took place. After visiting Nyamata memorial site, you will stop at a local eatery for lunch before proceeding to **Mbyo Reconciliation Village** where victims of the genocide both live together harmoniously. Gather firsthand knowledge by listening to their survival stories, and togetherness now as one. Upon completion you will drive back to Kigali and dropped off at your hotel to have dinner and spend the evening at leisure. Community-based Cultural Experience day in rural Rwanda

After breakfast you will drive to Muhanga to experience a full day of Azizi life.

Today you will totally immerse ourselves into their ways of life. You will meet everyone in the small local community. You will take part in several traditional and cultural activities, such as **beehive making**, local **cooking lesson**, **basket weaving**, a **cultural performance and so much more**. You will enjoy a traditional lunch and dinner mutually prepared with our Azizi hosts. Upon completion of this enriching cultural immersive experience, you will drive back to Kigali and spend the evening at leisure.

Lake Kivu – Is One of African Great Lakes. It lies on the border between the Democratic Republic of the Congo and Rwanda, and is in the Albertine Rift, The Western branch of the East African Rift. Lake Kivu empties in the Ruzizi River, which flows southwards into Lake Tanganyika.

After a relaxed breakfast you will be driven to **Gisenyi**, along the way you will visit **Roz Car House** and learn about the great work of this amazing lady, how she socially and economically impacted the lives of the local community. Visit her flower garden and living house, later proceed with a visit to the **tea factory** where you learn about the **tea process** with a visit to the **tea estates**. You will proceed with the drive to Gisenyi for lunch, before visiting **Atalia de Pupee women center**, where **local widows** participate in the **local artwork**, to make ends meet. You can purchase their artwork to show support as they work very hard to make a living. Upon completion of the tours, you will proceed to check in at Paradise Kivu owned by a local black woman. You will relax until our sumptuous group dinner made from organically grown produce from our host garden. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Lake Kivu Exploration – Coffee Plantation Tour, Scenic Boat Ride, Rabavu City Tour



LEISURE DAY


